Should you join us, here is some information to look over:

The official languages of the conference are **Bulgarian** and **English**.

Abstracts:

Abstracts should contain no more than 200 words and include a clearly articulated research problem, original ideas, objectives, methods, results and conclusions.

Abstracts should be accompanied by 5-10 key words.

Participants can submit applications for a maximum of two reports, in one case as authors and in the other – as co-authors.

Application must be submitted through the online conference system.

Participants can access the website of the conference [II Balkan International Student and PhD Conference](#) and register for participation by filling in the **registration form**.

Important dates:

Deadline for sending a request for participation and an abstract: **15 April, 2026**

Full paper submission: **10 June, 2026**

The materials of the conference will be published in the Student Almanac of the Faculty of Education at Trakia University – Stara Zagora.

Conference fees:

The fee for participation for students is **50 EUR**. For all participants from Bulgaria, a special fee for the host country of **25 EUR** is accepted.

The fee for PhD students is **70 EUR**. A special fee for the host country of **35 EUR** is accepted for all PhD students from Bulgaria.

Co-authors pay a fee of **40 EUR** for students/**60 EUR** for PhD students and university staff members. Co-authors from Bulgaria pay a fee of **20 EUR** for students/**30 EUR** for PhD students and university staff members.

Listener fee: **40 EUR/20 EUR** for Bulgarian participants.

The university staff members can participate only as co-authors.

The fee includes the materials from the conference, publication of the reports in an electronic format and an official cocktail.

Deadline for payment: **20 April, 2026**. Fees should be paid by bank transfer only.
